2 Parts of the Soldiers Footwear

Greave

made of brass/beautifully tooled metal
custom fitted to calf
bound tightly with leather strips

Shoe

bottom made of brass
held together with durable leather
spikes – up to 3” long

Defensive & Offensive

Greaves protect you when you traverse difficult terrain
Shoes keep the enemy under your feet
