



## Qualifications of V•GROUP Leaders

Christians who are in places of responsibility in the church are required to be examples in faith, conduct and business affairs. To maintain “The Spirit of Excellence” for leaders is one of the best ways to present Christ to people of our community. Therefore, the following expectations are desired of any person who leads a V•GROUP.

1. Be an active member of VWC for a minimum of three months
2. Be an active member of a VWC small group for a minimum of three months
3. Be loyal to the Pastor and leaders of VWC and have an attitude of support and submission to VWC authority
4. Be faithful in tithing to VWC
5. Be in agreement with the Statement of Faith & vision of VWC
6. Faithfully attend regular church services
7. Live a separated Christian life with commitment to Christian character and sound moral conduct inside and outside of Victory World Church.  
(To help maintain the integrity of the group leader and members, in most cases, men will lead “men only” groups and women will lead “women only” groups.)
8. Ensure your home life remains in order in accordance with Biblical principles and standards
9. Be fully committed to the Bible as the inspired and infallible word of God
10. Have an attitude of compassion and grace towards others
11. Be able to make a minimum six-month commitment to leading a group
12. Submit a thirty (30) day transition notice when resigning your position
13. Submit V•GROUP Leader Application and Background Check
14. Attend required V•GROUP Leadership Training Camps I, II, and III
