BEATITUDE BOWL

Supplies: 8 Beatitude Cards per team, Beatitude descriptions on screen, 2 buzzers or bells

Live Host: Alright, Victory Kids, I need **6 contestants (2 teams of 3)** to join me on stage! It's time for the ultimate Beatitude challenge. Today we're going to see how well you've listened to what Jesus taught in the Beatitudes. Each team will receive 8 Beatitude cards. I will read and display on the screen one Beatitude description at a time. When the timer starts, each team has 5 seconds to hold up the Beatitude card they believe matches the description. I will reveal the correct answer and the team with the correct match receives 1 point. The team with the most points at the end of the game receives 2 Bible Bucks each.

HEAD, KDEES, ALL ABOALD

Supplies: 1 toy train or a small plush train, tape to mark where each contestant should stand

Live Host: Alright Victory Kids! Who's ready for a super-fast, super-fun showdown? Shout YES! I need 2 contestants to come up and face each other on stage. Let's give a round of applause as they come up! This game is called Head, Knees, All Aboard! and here's how it works:

Between our two contestants is this very important train. (Hold up the item.) This train reminds us of our series: All Aboard: Let Jesus Lead the Way! But only one person will get to board the train each round! I'm going to call out different parts of the body like this: "Head! Knees! Shoulders! Toes!" And you'll follow along and touch each spot. But listen carefully... when I say "All Aboard!", you have to grab the train as fast as you can!

Whoever grabs it first wins that round and receives 1 Bible Buck! (Do a practice round: "Head! Knees! Head! Shoulders! Toes! ALL ABOARD!")

LIVE HOST'S INTEO TO LESSON

5-7 MINS

Live Host: Hey Victory Kids! How's everybody doing today? Welcome aboard! It's a brand-new year, and we're kicking it off with one last ride on our theme: All Aboard: Let Jesus Lead the Way!

This month, we're continuing on the final part of our journey, which is all about following Jesus. When we follow Him, we become His disciples: people who listen to His voice, learn from His Word, and live out His love every single day! Just like a train stays on track to reach its destination, Jesus helps guide us in the right direction. When we trust Him and follow where He leads, we can be confident that His way is always the best way.

Last week, we learned that Jesus began teaching His followers something called the **Beatitudes** "special blessings" that show what kind of heart God blesses.

This week, Jesus keeps teaching, but He adds something new. He shows us that when we live with those kinds of hearts: humble, tender, and hungry for God, our lives start to shine!

So, get ready, Victory Kids! It's time to hop aboard, open your hearts, and let Jesus lead the way!

MINISTRY LESSON

10 Mins

Supplies needed: Remote

Live Host Hook: Hold up a TV remote or game controller. "Who here has ever fought over the remote? Why? Because whoever has the remote... controls everything! If I press a button, the volume goes up. I can change the channel. I can even turn the whole thing OFF. That's a lot of power for a tiny device, right? But imagine if this remote could control everything, the weather, your school day, your whole world. That would be crazy!

Well, Jesus told His disciples something even bigger. He said, 'All power in heaven and on earth has been given to Me.' That means Jesus has authority over EVERYTHING, way more than any remote or controller." And right before He gave His disciples their mission, Jesus reminded them who was really in control, not of a TV, but of the whole world.

Jesus Gives Us Power and Authority

The Bible says in Matthew 28:18, "Then Jesus came to them and said, 'All power in heaven and on earth has been given to Me." That means Jesus has all authority; He's in charge of everything! And here's the amazing part: Jesus doesn't keep that power to Himself. When we follow Him, He shares His power with us through the Holy Spirit. No, we don't suddenly become superheroes, but we do get His strength to do what He calls us to do.

It's His power that helps us be brave when we feel scared, make good choices when it's hard, love others even when they're unkind, and tell people about Jesus even if we feel nervous. Jesus knows we can't do His mission alone. So, He gives us His power so we can live for Him and help others know Him. When Jesus sends us, He strengthens us. When He calls us, He gives us what we need. When He leads us, He gives us His powers to do His will.

Jesus Sends Us to Make Disciples

In Matthew 28:18, Jesus said, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to Me." And that's really good news for us. Because when Jesus sends us out to do something, we don't go alone, we go with His strength. He said in Matthew 28:19, "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit!

Then Jesus gave His followers their mission: and do you know what this mission was called? It was called "the Great Commission." Hey! Let's all say that together 1-2-3, *The Great Commission*! The Great Commission is not a suggestion, Jesus commands every one of His followers to GO and make disciples by telling them about Jesus. The Great Commission is the way we help others Know Jesus, Follow Jesus, and Share Jesus.

Say it with me! Know Jesus, Follow Jesus, and Share Jesus!

Say it one more time! Know Jesus, Follow Jesus, and Share Jesus!

Have you ever told someone about something you were really excited about: maybe a new game, movie, or snack? You couldn't wait to share it, right? That's how we should feel about Jesus! We've experienced His love, and now we get to share that love with others. When we follow Jesus, we become part of His mission, helping others get "on board" to follow Him too.

Jesus Promises to Be with Us

After giving His followers this big assignment, Jesus made a promise. And this promise still stands today. In Matthew 28:20, He said, "You can be sure that I will be with you always." Jesus didn't send His disciples out alone. He promised that the Holy Spirit would be with them to give them courage, wisdom, and strength. And that same Holy Spirit helps us, too!

Have you ever been nervous to do something new, like trying out for a team, talking in front of the class, or walking into a new group? It's scary at first. But when you know someone strong is standing with you, it gives you courage. That's what Jesus does for us. When we follow Him, we can step out with confidence, because His power goes with us. He leads the way, and when He says, "Go," we can trust that He knows exactly where He's guiding us.

S.O.A.P

S.O.A.P is a simple but helpful way to study the Bible and apply it to our own lives.

S.O.A.P stands for, **SCRIPTURE**, **OBSERVATIR**, **APPLICATIR** AND **PRAYER** and involves four simple steps.

S: SCRIPTURE

You physically write out the scripture. You'll be amazed what God will reveal to you just by taking the time to slow down and actually write out what you are reading!

0: OBSCRVatin

What do you notice about the verses? What do you think the main message is? What verses, words or ideas jump out to you? Who is the audience? Is there a repetition of words?

A: APPLICATION

Ask God how He wants you to apply the verse to your own life. This is when God's Word becomes personal. What is God saying to me today? How can I apply what I just read to my own personal life? What changes do I need to make? Is there an action that I need to take?

P: PRayer

Pray God's Word back to Him. If He has revealed something to you during this time in His Word, pray about it. Confess if He has revealed some sin that is in your life.


