



Under Construction: God at Work

LESSON - I CAN TELL OTHERS ABOUT JESUS!

Welcome back to Under Construction: God at Work! This month, we have been learning about Peter. Jesus called Peter to follow Him. Jesus taught Peter to love Him and help others. Today, we'll learn how God helped Peter be brave and tell many people about Jesus!

SAY IT: God helps me!

DO IT: Give two thumbs up.

After Jesus went back to heaven, Peter and Jesus' friends waited just as Jesus told them to do. Then God kept His promise! God sent the Holy Spirit to help them. Peter was no longer afraid. God helped Peter be brave.

SAY IT: God makes me brave!

DO IT: Make a Muscle.

Peter stood up and told everyone about Jesus. Many people listened to Peter. They believed in Jesus because Peter shared the good news. Peter wasn't brave all by himself. God helped him every step of the way.

SAY IT: Peter told everybody about Jesus!

DO IT: Cup your hands around your mouth and whisper.

God can help us too! We can tell others that Jesus loves them. We can invite a friend to church, pray for someone, and show kindness every day. When we do, we are sharing the love of Jesus.

SAY IT: I can tell others about Jesus!

DO IT: Point up.

Today we learned that God helped Peter be brave. Peter told many people about Jesus, and many believed. God helps us too! We can tell others that Jesus loves them and share His love every day.

SAY IT: God helps me share Jesus!

DO IT: Raise your hands high and smile

PRAYER: Dear Jesus, thank You for helping Peter be brave. Thank You for helping us too. Help us tell others that You love them. Help us be kind, loving, and brave every day. We love You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

LESSON QUESTIONS - 10 MINS

2 & 3YR OLDS

1. Did God help Peter? **(Yes)**
2. Was Peter afraid forever? **(No)**
3. Did Peter tell people about Jesus? **(Yes)**
4. Can we tell others about Jesus? **(Yes)**

4YRS - 1st GRADE

1. Who helped Peter be brave? **God (the Holy Spirit)**
2. Who did Peter tell people about? **Jesus**
3. Did people listen to Peter? **Yes**
4. What happened after Peter shared the good news about Jesus? **Many people believed in Jesus**



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ACTIVITY 1: PASS THE GOOD NEWS

Items Needed: Plush Bible

Connection: Peter shared God's message.

Step 1: Children stand in a circle.

Step 2: Have the children pass the Bible to the person next to them.

Step 3: As they pass the Bible, have them say to the person Jesus loves you!

ACTIVITY 2: GOOD NEWS PARADE

Items Needed: Streamers or rhythm sticks (optional)

Connection: Peter told everyone about Jesus.

Step 1: March around the room.

Step 2: Repeat together: Jesus is alive and He loves me; Jesus is alive and He loves you!

ACTIVITY 3: BUBBLE PARTY OR STORY TIME

Items Needed: Bubbles and music OR book basket

CRAFT 1: JESUS LOVES ME CRAFT

Items Needed: Syhood 24 Sets Jesus Loves Me Heart Craft Kit

Connection: Share the Good News that Jesus Loves You

Step 1: Pass out craft kits

Step 2: Help children assemble

Step 3: Help children write their name on the top of their paper.

CRAFT 2: SHARE THE GOOD NEWS COLORING SHEET

Items Needed: Coloring sheet and crayons.

Connection: Let's share the Good News about Jesus.

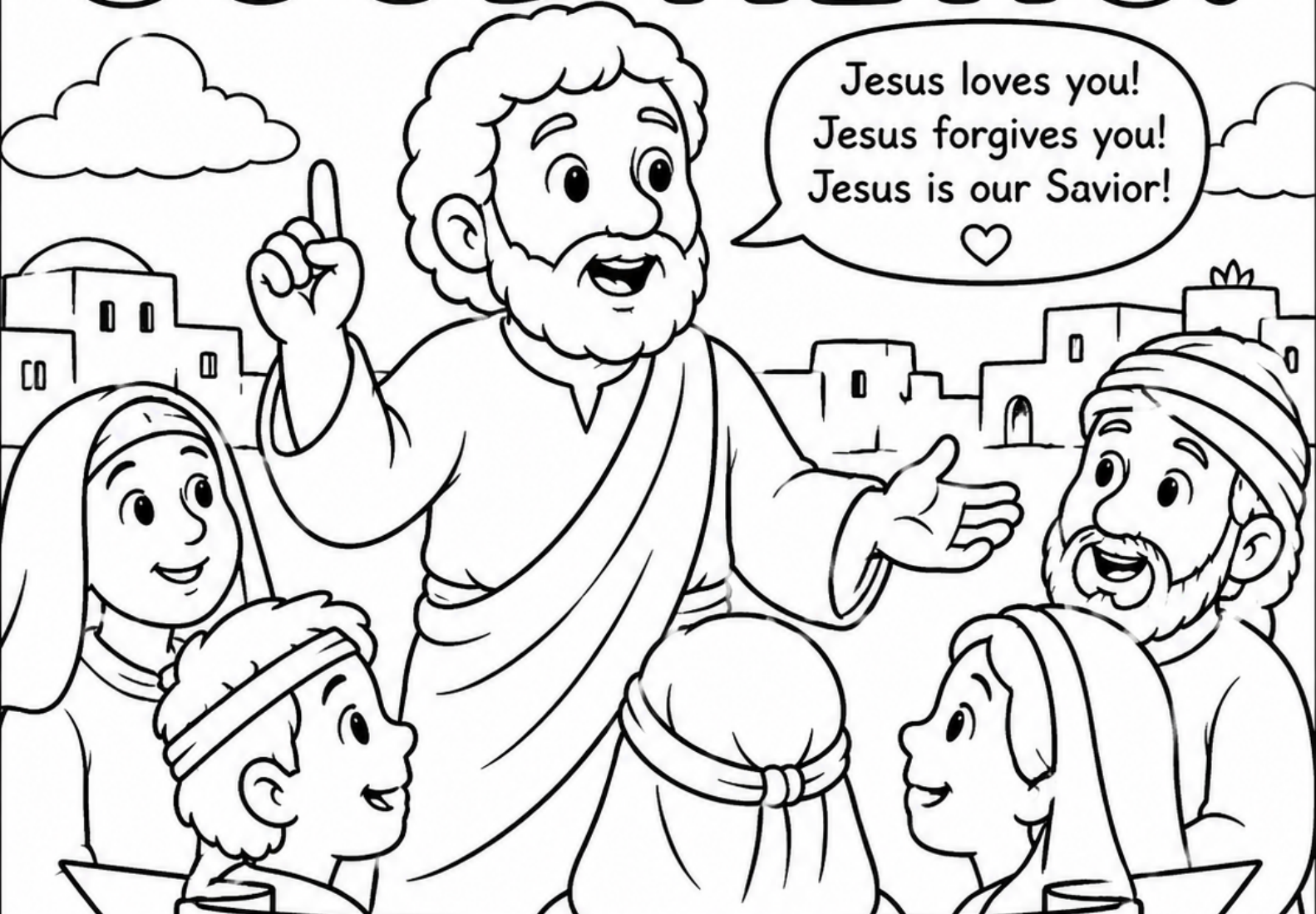
Step 1: Distribute the coloring sheets and allow time to color.
